# Proposal to change of constitution (in respect of the Club presidency) 

## Current statement:

10.2 A President shall be nominated by the Executive Board for election at the Annual General Meeting. Any Member wishing to suggest a nomination shall submit the name to the Chief Executive by no later than the 31 January immediately prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Club for consideration by the Executive Board.
10.3 The President has to be a Member of the Club and shall be elected for a period of two years. At the expiration of the term of office he or she shall not be eligible for re-election as President until after the expiration of at least two years from the conclusion of his or her last year of service in that office.

## Proposed change:

10.2 A President shall be nominated by the Executive Board for election at the Annual General Meeting. Any Member wishing to suggest a nomination shall submit the name to the Chief Executive by no later than the 31 January immediately prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Club for consideration by the Executive Board.
10.3 The President has to be a Member of the Club and shall be elected for an initial period of three years. At the expiration of the first term of office he or she shall be eligible for reelection as President for a further two years. At the expiration of the second term of office he or she shall not be eligible for re-election as President until after the expiration of at least three years from the conclusion of his or her last year of service in that office. At the expiration of the three year period, he or she may be elected to serve a final term of [two] years. In any event no one may serve more than a total of [seven] years as President.
