


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 14, 15	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1300, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads/ South Wales will be diverted and not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham and will depart up to 30 minutes EARLIER than usual. Some services between London Paddington and South Wales/Cheltenham Spa will start/terminate at Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Reading, Didcot Parkway and Swindon.
1d – 1h	Saturday - All day, services from Swansea to London Paddington will depart up to 8 minutes EARLIER than usual.
1d – 1h	Saturday – The 0559 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Bristol Parkway.
1d, 25a •	between Bristol lemple Meads and Cardiff Central.
1h •	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday – The 2115 and 2245 London Paddington to Swansea services will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run between Neath and Swansea.
1h	Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0354 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run between Swansea and Neath to connect with the train.
5a – 5f •	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – Each day, trains will not run between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. A special service will operate between London Paddington and Theale only, with replacement buses running for the rest of service between Theale and Newbury/Bedwyn. Trains between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted, with trains departing London Paddington up to 35 minutes EARLIER than usual. 8d •	Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough. Burnham and Taplow.
8f •	Friday - The 0017 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service will terminate at Twyford. Change at Twyford for an onwards rail connection
15	Saturday - From approximately 2315 until the end of service, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between
15	Sunday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15	Monday Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday - From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at
15	Friday - From approximately 2345 until 0530 Saturday 14 July, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between
15, 17, 19a, 19b	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1300, buses will replace trains between Reading and Didcot Parkway/Oxford. For more information, visit GWR.com/Oxford2018
17, 19a, 19b •	Saturday and Sunday – All day Saturday and from approximately 1300 Sunday afternoon until the end of service, trains will not run between Didcot Parkway and Moreton-in-Marsh. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford/Moreton-in-Marsh. A special rail service will operate between Moreton-in-Marsh and Worcester/The Malverns. 17, 19a, 19b	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – Each day, trains will not run between Didcot Parkway and Hanborough. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford/Hanborough. A special rail service will operate between Hanborough and Worcester/The Malverns/Hereford. 18	Saturday – All day, buses replace trains between Didcot Parkway/Oxford and Banbury. For more information, visit GWR.com/Oxford2018
18	Sunday – All day, buses replace trains between Oxford and Banbury. For more information, visit GWR.com/Oxford2018
18	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – Each day, buses replace trains between Didcot Parkway/Oxford and Banbury. For more information, visit GWR.com/Oxford2018
25a	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway. Services between Cardiff Central and Westbury/Brighton/Portsmouth Harbour/Taunton will start/terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. Some services may not run.
25a	Saturday – The 0645 Bristol Temple Meads to Swansea service will start from Bristol Parkway. An EARLIER replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway to connect with the train.
25a	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1400, trains between Worcester/Cheltenham Spa and Gloucester to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Bristol Parkway and terminate at Severn Tunnel Junction. Change at Severn Tunnel Junction for a replacement bus service to Newport. From approximately 1400 until the end of service these services will terminate/start from Cardiff Central. The 2233 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will terminate at Bristol Parkway. Please travel on alternative services from London Paddington to complete your journey.
25a	Monday – The 0445 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will start from Bristol Parkway. An EARLIER replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway to connect with the train.
25a, 29	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend, buses replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth/Severn Beach.
25e	 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – Each day, services between Swindon and Westbury/Frome will be significantly altered, with some services being cancelled. Replacement buses will run between Chippenham and Westbury for affected services. For more information, visit GWR.com/Newbury2018
