INTRODUCTION

Probably the most famous Cricketer of all time, W.G. Grace co-founded our Club and captained our team at the outset. His name is synonymous with Gloucestershire Cricket and without him the Club may not exist today.

The GCCC Heritage Trust, with assistance from Mrs Marie Journeaux, the Club's President, has been exploring the idea of a permanent commemoration to W.G. With help from Adam Chadwick, Curator of Collections at the Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) it is envisaged that the bust of W.G., which stands in the Lord's Museum, will be re-cast in bronze and positioned at the Bristol County Ground.

It has been quite a journey but it is hoped that we can proudly unveil the bronze bust to coincide with the Club's 150th Anniversary in 2020. With your support we are certain this can be achieved.

Permission has been gained from the MCC Arts and Library Committee for the bust to be re-cast and Pangolin Editions Ltd (www.pangolin-editions.com) will produce the bronze.

The model will be cast into bronze, metal finished and patinated as a 'classic' bronze using traditional heat treatment methods. A plinth will then be created to suit an outdoor display.



The approximate cost will be **£15,000** and the measurements will be:

Height: 690mm (27")

Width: 640mm (25")

Depth: 435mm (17")

TIMESCALE

This will be dependent on time spent finishing the design and key sign-offs at critical stages but 10 months would be an approximate time from the placing of an order to delivery and installation by Pangolin Editions Ltd at the Bristol County Ground.

A plate, to be affixed to the plinth, will include the names of all those who contribute £50 or more to the cost, plus words of recognition to the MCC.
