Our home, the Bristol County Ground, is based in the heart of the city just off the Gloucester Road. In recent years, the redevelopment of our facilities has transformed the ground and has enabled us to become a thriving International sporting venue.

The Bristol County Ground has a real sense of place in the city with its transformational street art branding. LOCAL CHARITY PARTNER



Our local charity partner, to be based within a one-mile radius of The Bristol County Ground, will work with our immediate community.

We will aim to support them as neighbours on their causes of interest and importance.

The charity will receive match tickets, a match day collection opportunity, use of the Bristol County Ground facility, an invitation to club and partner events and Gloucestershire Cricket merchandise.



CITY CHARITY PARTNER

Our city-based charity partner will be based in Bristol.

> This partnership will embrace the culture of Bristol and look to support a charity tackling issues at the heart of the city.

> > This organisation will receive the equivalent to our local charity partner, plus our on-site gym charity rates, regular off-season facility use, a partnership video and a volunteer recognition day – a chance to reward those who volunteer their time to your cause.

COUNTY CHARITY PARTNER

Our county charity partner will work either solely in the county of Gloucestershire or be a National charity which has a branch/office directly impacting the county.

This partnership recognises that the club covers a large geographical footprint.

The charity will receive the equivalent to our city charity partner, plus match day hospitality places, player appearances at a bespoke charity event, an advertising board throughout the year and an invitation to club events including the End of Season Awards evening.
